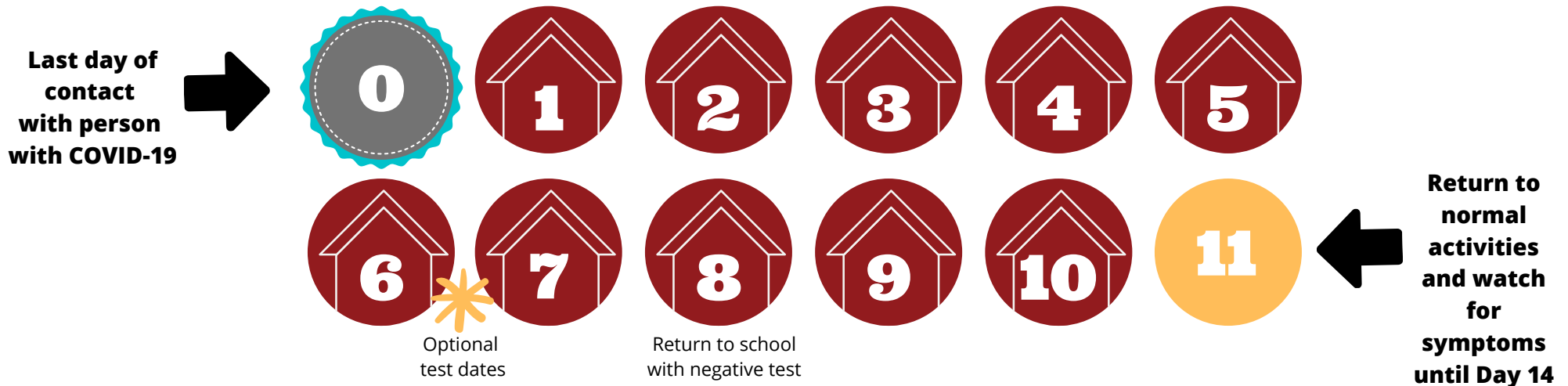


When is it safe for students to return to school and other activities after **QUARANTINE**?

Quarantine is separating oneself from others after being exposed to a disease for the recommended period of time in case you are infected and are contagious.



Quarantine

Day 0 - Last date of close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes over a 24-hour period)

Day 10 - Last day of quarantine

Day 11 - Return to school

Example:

Day 0 - Last date of close contact (August 27)

Day 10 - Last day of quarantine (September 6)

Day 11 - Return to school (September 7)

Optional 7-Day Quarantine with Negative Test

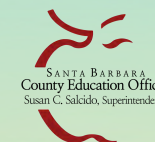
If test specimen is collected Day 6 or Day 7 from the last date of exposure and results are negative, student may return to school on Day 8.

Example:

Day 0 - Last date of close contact (August 27)

Test Day 6 or Day 7 (September 2nd or September 3)

May return to school Day 8 (September 4)



When is it safe for students to return to school and other activities after ISOLATION (testing positive for COVID-19 or presumed positive with symptoms)?



Isolation for Positive COVID Test Results

Day 0 - Day symptoms begin or receive a positive test date, if asymptomatic

Day 10 - Last day of isolation

Day 11 - Return to school

EXAMPLE: Symptomatic

Day 0 - Day symptoms began (August 27). Begin isolation.

Isolate for 10 days (September 6)

Day 11 - Return to school on Day 11 (September 7)

EXAMPLE: Asymptomatic

Day 0 - Positive test date (August 27) Begin isolation.

Isolate for 10 days (September 6)

Day 11 - Return to school on Day 11 (September 7)



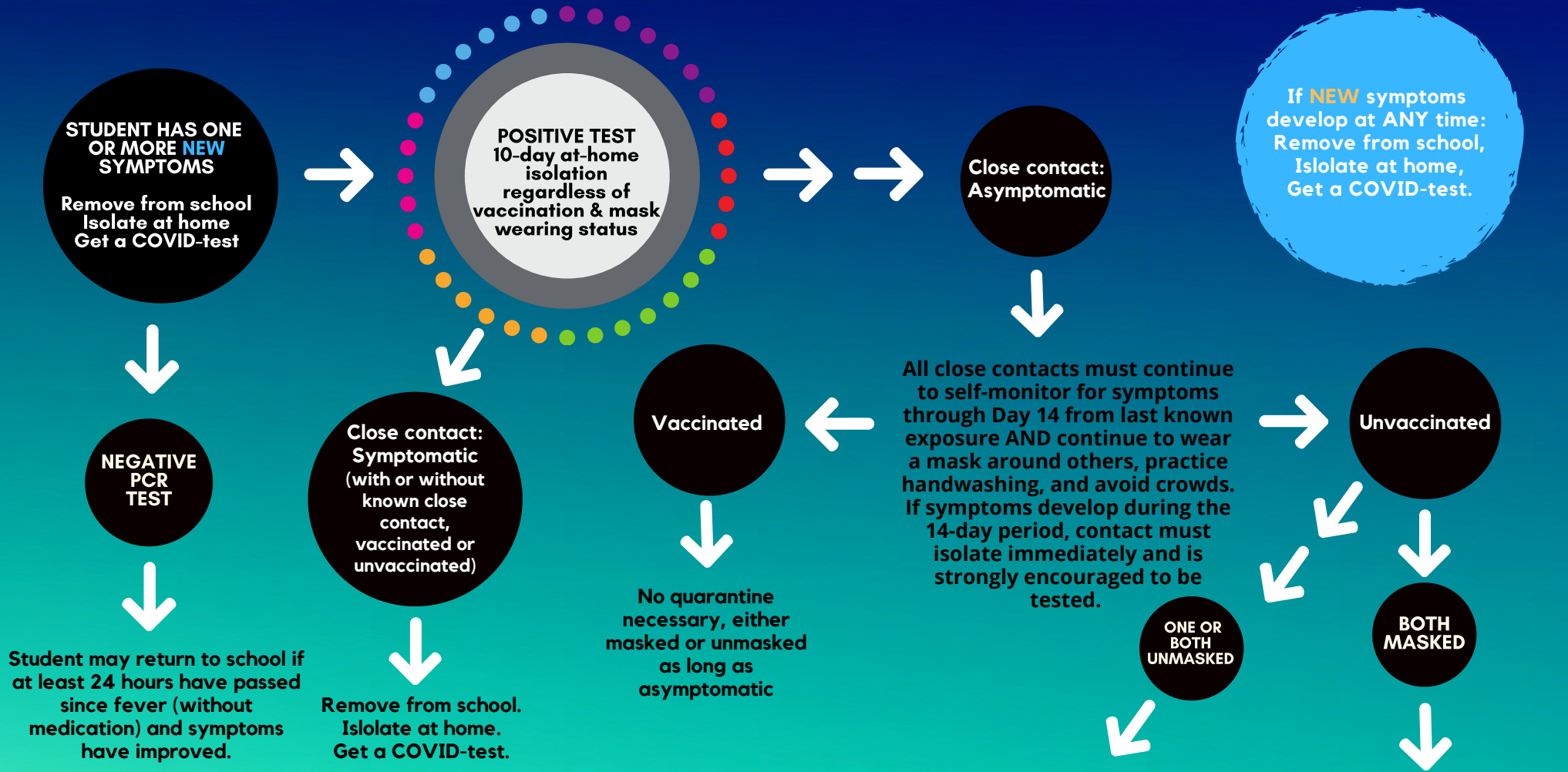
To be released from isolation the following criteria must be met, in addition to the 10 days: At least 24 hours have passed without fever (without fever-reducing medications) AND other symptoms have improved.



What happens when students have close contact with a positive case in school settings (minimum requirements)?

*Masked or unmasked, close contact is defined as within 6 feet for 15 minutes cumulatively within a 24-hour period.

If **NEW** symptoms develop at ANY time: Remove from school, Isolate at home, Get a COVID-test.

SYMPTOMS
Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.

These symptoms may also be associated with a known chronic condition or another medical condition as determined by a healthcare provider. The concern is when symptoms are **NEW** or there has been close contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

Quarantine at home. Quarantine ends after Day 10 from exposure OR if asymptomatic, a negative test on Day 6 or Day 7 will enable the student to return to school on Day 8.

If the exposure occurred at school and the contact is asymptomatic: continues to attend school. Does not participate in extracurricular activities in school or community setting. Contact must continue to wear mask indoors and undergo testing at least twice during 10-day quarantine. A negative test on Day 6 or Day 7 will enable the student to return to school on Day 8.
